On November 23, 1963, one day after the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, the Central Intelligence Appency's Resident City Station suppresented to Resident officials that they arrest Sylvia Triedo de Duran. (Mexi 1929 to the Director, Nov. 23, 1963) The Residence City Station asked that Sylvia Triedo de Duran the beld incommunicado watil she told the Mexican officials everything she knew about Lee Harvey Oswald. The Residen government arrested Sylvia Triedo de Duran the same day. Captain Fernando Gutlerrer Batrios.
