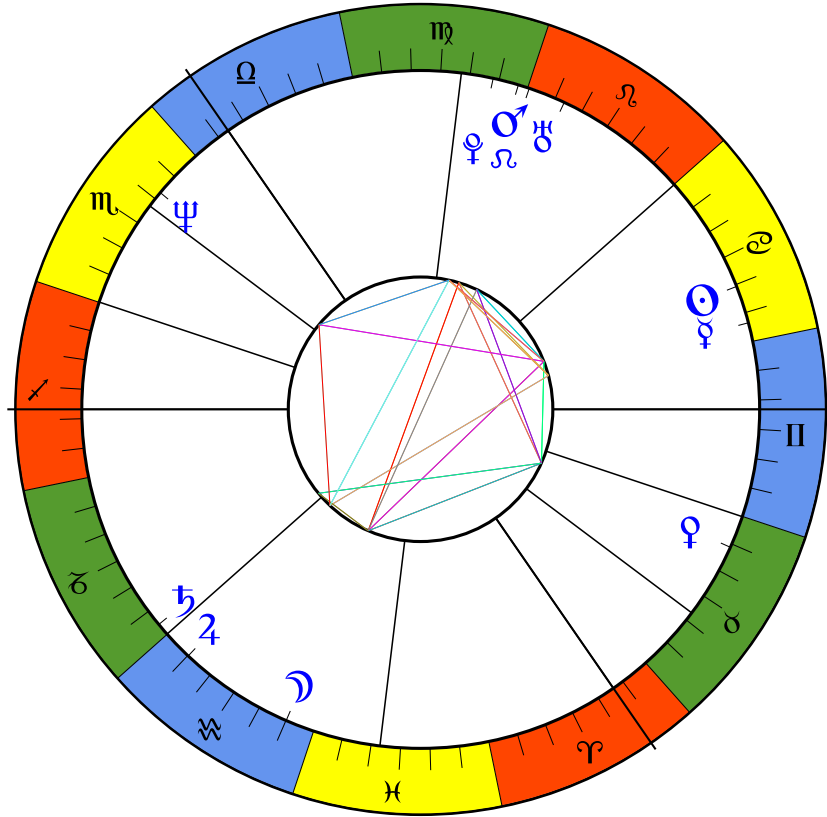

Cancer; Your Sun Sign



Your Sun sign is what most people refer to as your zodiac sign. It is the sign that you look up in a newspaper or magazine when you want to read a prediction. I have begun this character analysis with a look at what it means - so that we can 'get it out of the way' and start exploring your personality in greater depth. The truth is, you see, that none of us are totally typical of our signs. We may have certain traits that we share with everyone else born in the same month-long period of the year but there will always be other traits that are uniquely our own.

Sun in Cancer

Sun in the Seventh House

The following words describe characteristics imbued by your time of birth.

So, logically enough, if we aren't sure of that moment, we can't be sure of the remarks below!

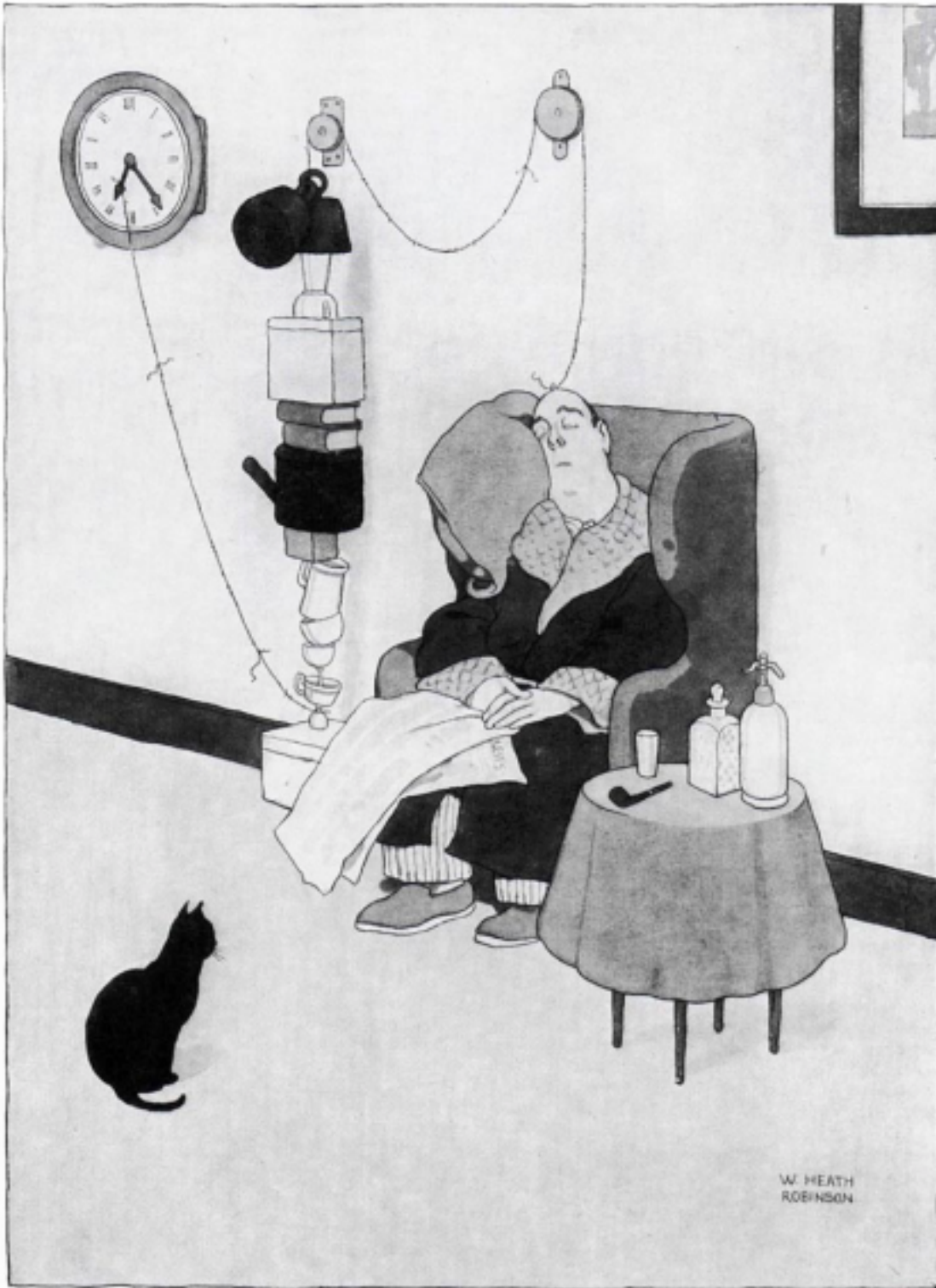
Are you still here? Have you fallen asleep? Are your eyes glazed over as you struggle to fathom what any of this has to do with you or your horoscope?

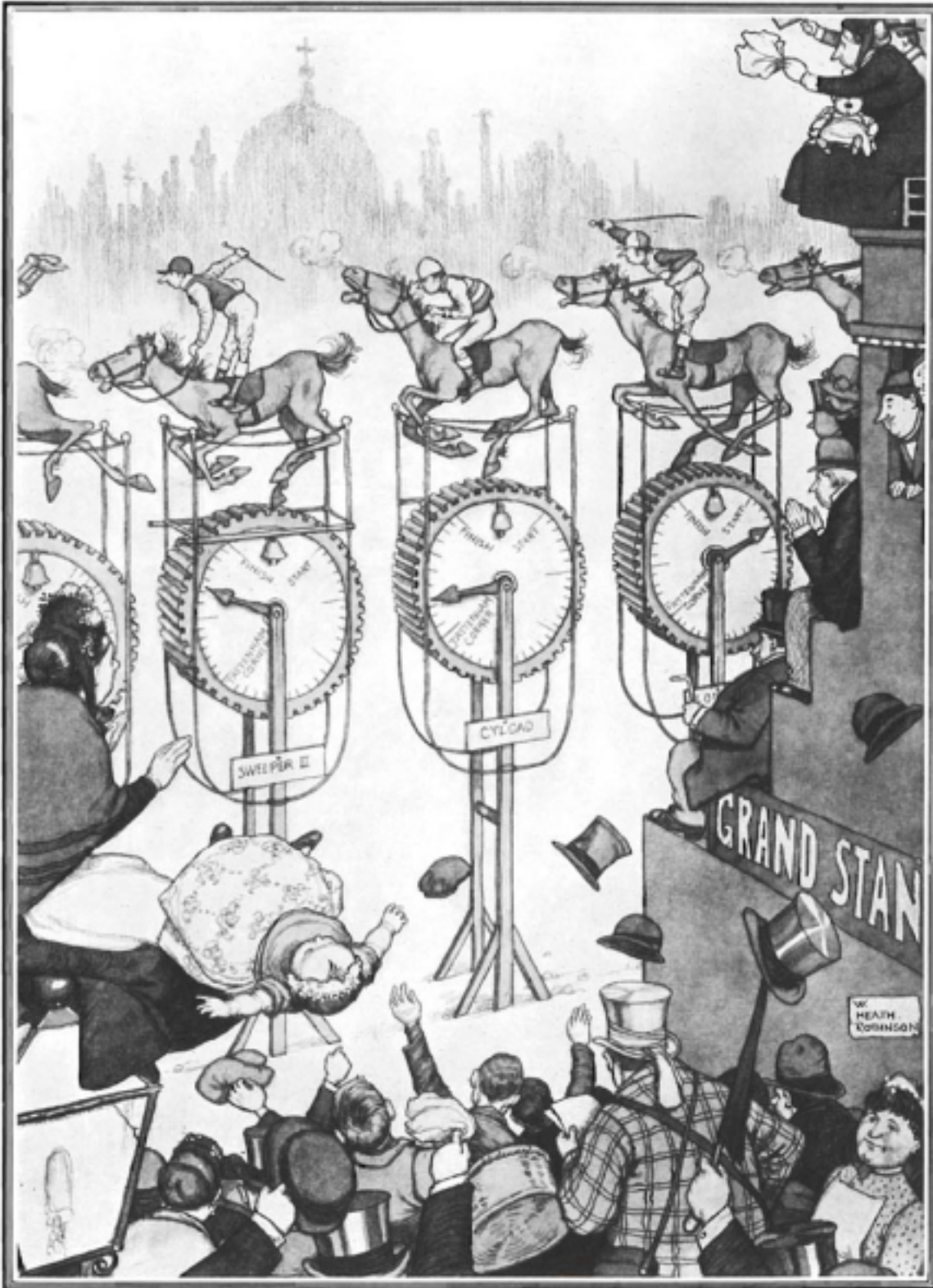

If you think of your horoscope as a wiring diagram, Saturn depicts the point where the "off switch" goes. It describes the things that you cannot tolerate, the points past which you will not go and the issues you simply prefer not to think about. We all need a good strong ability to say "no" when it is appropriate. Sometimes though, we find ourselves saying no to things that it might be far better to say yes to. If Saturn is forming a "quincunx" or, perhaps a semi sextile to another planet, it depicts the way in which you're often under pressure to break your own rules. A 'hard aspect' such as an opposition or square tends to reveal the way in which other people and situations challenge you to say no to ideas and suggestions. You may say no too easily. You may spend a lifetime learning how to say no. Either way, that's the area of life in which 'no' poses some problems. Wherever Saturn trines, conjuncts or sextiles another planet, you're naturally able to see what's good or bad for you and to apply self discipline with ease and grace.

You were born during a two to three year period when Saturn was passing through the sign of Capricorn. While some astrologers offer interpretations about the personal influence of slow moving planets like Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto in each zodiac sign, and whilst once, I too, observed this traditional convention, most modern astrologers feel that these insights are of very limited value.. Whatever traits they bestow, they surely bestow equally on all born in (in Saturn's case at least) at two to three year period. Of far greater importance is the position that Saturn occupies by house and by aspect to other planets in your horoscope.

Saturn in the First House

You are very conscious and slightly concerned about what other people may think of you. Interestingly, other people tend to think of you as somewhat fierce and unapproachable. They see you as an authority figure. To some extent, that suits you. It helps you guard your privacy and allows you to protect the softer, more vulnerable nature of your personality. You react and respond to fear by being active. For you, the things that upset you are the same things that cause you to get up and go. You compensate for any inferiority you feel by being assertive, aggressive, independent and strong willed.

Saturn Semisextiles Moon

You are rather afraid of (and at the same time rather attracted to) the idea of being alone. You do not like to be 'put on the spot' emotionally and prefer to keep yourself distant and separate from situations that might reveal you to be emotionally vulnerable. Even so, you have your feelings and you can't always hide them. When relaxed, your guard comes down, you stop caring so much about whether you care too much and you actually become quite good fun.

Saturn Trines Venus

You like to feel stable and secure. It's difficult for you to relax and enjoy yourself if you don't. Where some people thrive on a little uncertainty and excitement, you need to know where you stand and what you are dealing with. Only then can you allow yourself to get creative, to fully enjoy the company of others and to open your heart. Theories and philosophies don't interest you unless they have a real practical purpose. You find yourself particularly drawn to similarly pragmatic, down-to-earth types.

Saturn Conjuncts Jupiter

You were born under a rare conjunction of two planets. It only happens once every 20 years, the full explanation of this can be found in the section of your birth chart that describes the influence of Jupiter.

Epilogue

...And on that note, we'll finish your chart reading. We hope you have enjoyed it. We also rather hope that you have not immediately recognised yourself in every sentence of every paragraph. If all we'd managed to do was tell you what you already know, we might be making an impressive demonstration of astrology... but we'd hardly be doing you much service as your astrologer.

Our job is to draw your attention to aspects of your own personality that you may not be so immediately aware of. We want to help you identify hidden talents, to see areas of strength within yourself and to understand, as well, your weaknesses, fears and worries. That's not so you can have an 'excuse' for behavioural tendencies or for adopting particular attitudes. It's so you can know yourself better and change yourself (if you choose to) more effectively.

Change is always possible. Indeed, it is inevitable in every life. If we wait long enough, change will sooner or later come to us. If we step out along the road towards change, it will rapidly see what we are up to and start running along to greet us. If now, or at any point in your life, you want something big to change in your life, we recommend you read your horoscope again, paying particular attention to the bits that don't seem to make much sense to you. Be particularly alert to the descriptions of characteristics that you feel you don't possess. If they're positive, embrace them. They're yours! If they're not so positive, face them. They may just be yours, even if you don't realise it... and they may need to be overcome! We are never 'cursed at birth' with an issue we can't resolve or a problem we may never be able to solve. We are simply given tendencies which we can move closer to or further away from. That's what free will is all about.

One last point. This reading has been a 'character analysis'. It has interpreted the positions of the planets as they stood at your moment of birth. But astrology can also be used to predict future influences and challenges. To do that, we need to take your basic birth chart (the one we have been commenting on all through this document) and then compare the positions of the planets as they were back then, to the positions they will be in the coming months, years or even decades. That's a painstaking process but the upshot is a very accurate assessment of what you'll be up against, what will be easy for you - and what you are most likely to be blessed by at any point, on any day of your future.
