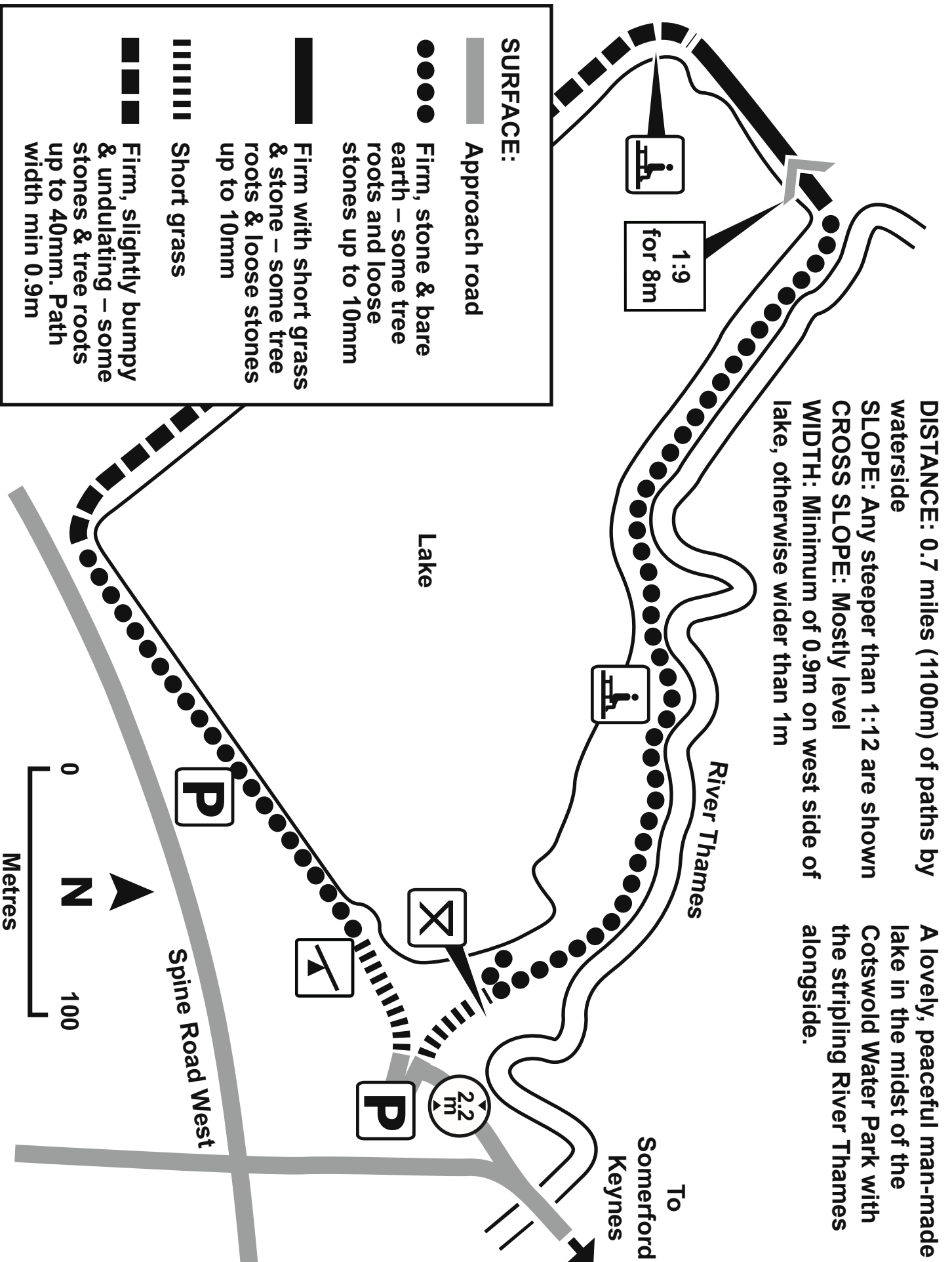


# NEIGH BRIDGE COUNTRY PARK



# HOW TO GET TO NEIGH BRIDGE

MAP: OS Landranger 163, grid ref SU018947

ROAD: Go to [www.gridref.org.uk](http://www.gridref.org.uk) – insert grid ref above and click ‘find a place’. The car park is at Lake 56, north off Spine Road West, 5 miles west off the A419 between Cirencester and Cricklade (B4696 junction).

## ROUTE DESCRIPTION

A circular route around this peaceful lake. Please note that the path is relatively narrow (minimum of 0.9m) along the west side without any passing place.



## POINTS OF INTEREST

Neigh Bridge is one of 133 lakes created by gravel extraction in the Cotswold Water Park, Britain's largest water park. It is a great place to see a range of wildlife; during winter it hosts over 20,000 waterfowl of at least 40 different species, some of which you're bound to see on a visit to this site.
