British Waterways London looks after 100 miles of canals and rivers and 110 acres of docks in and around the capital. The canals and rivers are a unique leisure asset and provide a scenic and atmospheric alternative to the hustle and bustle of city life.

Most of the canals and rivers are available for angling and the majority are leased to clubs who control day-to-day fishing on their stretch. 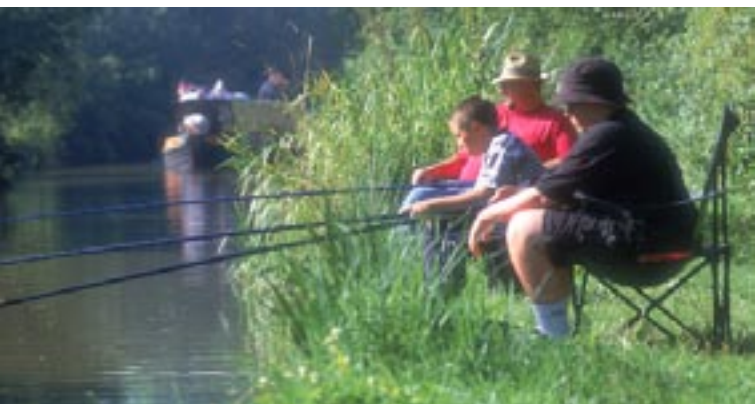
NATIONAL ROD LICENCE

Before angling on fresh water in England and Wales you must obtain a National Rod Licence issued by the Environment Agency.

Licences can be obtained from every Post Office in England and Wales, by telephoning 0870 1662662 (for Full and Junior Concessionary licences only) or online from the Environment Agency website www.environment-agency.gov.uk

THE WATERWAYS CODE

Many people use the towpath for boating, walking and cycling as well as for angling.

Look after your waterways

- Discard hooks and lines, bottles and tins can kill or injure wildlife. Please take your litter home with you.

Consider others

- Make sure the towpath is easily passable by keeping your fishing tackle tidy.

- Please don't obstruct locks, bridges, designated moorings, water points or turning points.

- Boat crews need access to the bank within 25 metres of locks or moveable bridges so please do not fish there.

- Boats are people's homes so please respect their privacy. Try to fish at least 15 metres away.

- Use a pole cup if you need to fish close to boats; don't throw or catapult groundbait on to the decks or against the hulls of boats. It damages paintwork.

- Don't bounce tackle off boats or tap them with pole tips. Chipped paint is expensive to repair and hooks in ropes can be very dangerous.

- Some boats will not be able to avoid you if you fish on the outside of bends.

Take care

- Don't fish within 30 metres of overhead power lines. Look out and look up - electricity kills.
