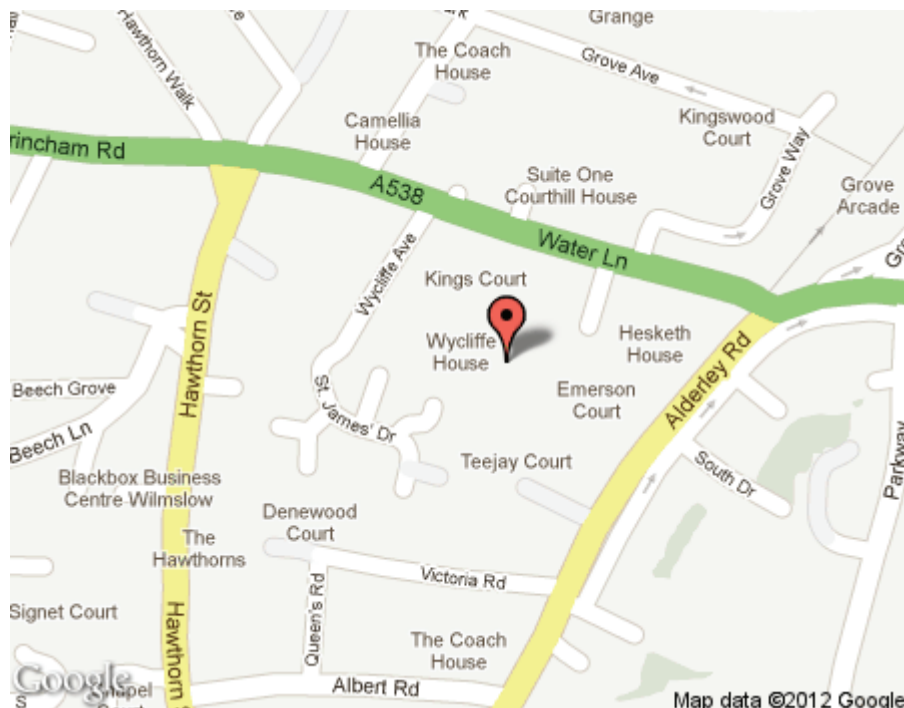

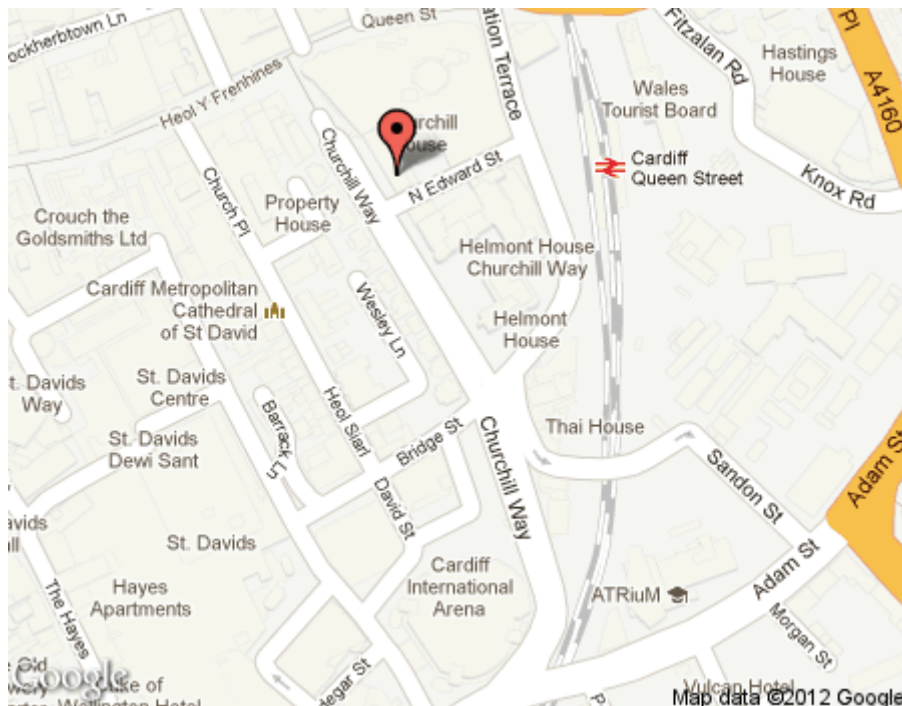

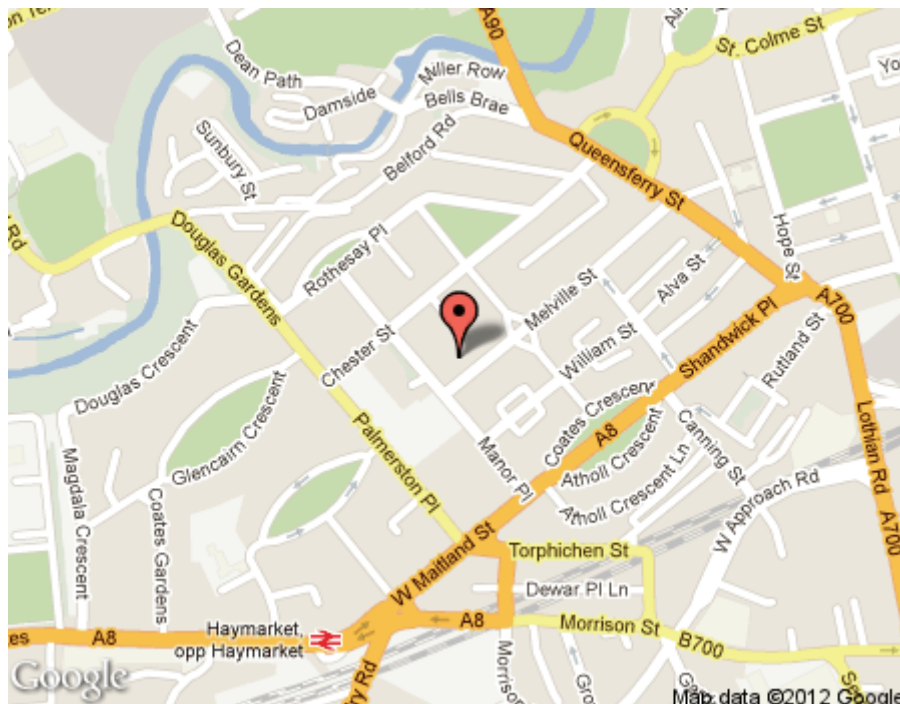

Our Scottish office is located in a Georgian building close to Edinburgh's New Town and within a few minutes walk of the west end of Princes St. Situated beside a number of consular buildings and with access to a private shared garden, the office is in a prime location with excellent bus and train links nearby. The main focus of our Scottish office is data protection – for which the ICO is Scotland's sole regulatory body.

Scotland has its own separate Information Commissioner who regulates the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act, which covers Scottish public authorities. However, we do have regulatory power under the (UK) FOI Act for UK public authorities based in Scotland, including The Forestry Commission, BBC Scotland and The Scottish Consumer Council.
