# **SAFETY NOTICE:** SCHOOL PARTIES



TEACHERS: We hope you enjoy your visit to the PSP Southampton Boat Show, but it covers a huge area so please brief your pupils on basic safety precautions. If you have a problem, contact our uniformed Security staff.

#### FOR PUPILS:

#### SBS2012

1. Wear one of the official Boat Show WRISTBANDS which you will be given when you arrive onsite. Write your Teacher's mobile number on it. School parties are not permitted to go onto the Marina. Do NOT go onto open decks of boats exhibited at height on the land. If it's sunny drink lots of water, wear a hat and put on plenty of suitable sunscreen. Always stay with your group, follow your Teachers advice and/or the quidance of our uniformed Security staff.

2. The LOST PERSONS MEETING POINT is at the main Entrance to the HOLIDAY INN. Please ensure that you know how to get there, or contact one of our uniformed Security staff. Don't wander off. Your Teacher will take a HEADCOUNT regularly and give a FLOORPLAN to you and each pupil. A floorplan is available at the Organisers Office.

3. FIRE ASSEMBLY POINT: In an emergency, a specific PA ANNOUNCEMENT will be broadcast. Please follow the directions of our uniformed Security staff.

4. FIRST AID: The First Aid Post is at 'E' Gate, or contact any of our uniformed Security staff, or call the Emergency Number below.

### FOR TEACHERS:

5. Schools must follow their own LEA Guidance. Where our safety advice is in conflict with LEA Guidance please implement the higher safety control measure.

6. ALL school parties should be registered with the Organisers prior to arriving onsite and there must be a designated GROUP LEADER. We recommend that young pupils wear hi-viz vests. Please sign and return the 'School Parties Safety Form' (attached).

7. The School must have undertaken a suitable and sufficient RISK ASSESSMENT.

8. The GROUP LEADER must have a mobile phone. Please ensure that the Organisers, the school and the pupils know it. Take a headcount regularly at the show.

9. There must be an appropriate ratio of teachers/adults to pupils.

10. Teachers must take action against any pupil that acts irresponsibly, does not follow basic safety guidance or is disruptive. Please take them and the group offsite.

11. ENSURE THAT ALL CHILDREN WEAR A WRISTBAND (available at show entrance) AT ALL TIMES ONSITE, WITH THE GROUP LEADERS MOBILE NUMBER WRITTEN ON IT.
