
National Solo Class Rule Interpretation – 01/12

The following interpretation is supplement to the “2011 National Solo Class rules (Effective 9th April 2011)” and shall remain in force until a subsequent version of the class rules are approved and published on the RYA website.

Question: Within the current class rules, in rule D.9.1(c) 4 what is meant by the term “Bailer”?

Answer: The term “bailer” in rule D.9.1(c) 4 is a term that describes a through hull fitting that facilitates draining water from the cockpit & can be removed from the hull. This fitting also has the capability of being opened and closed.”
