

National Squib Class Rule Interpretation – 01/12

The following interpretation is supplement to the “2009 National Squib Class rules (Effective June 2009)” and shall remain in force until a subsequent version of the class rules are approved and published on the RYA website.

**Question:** Within the National Squib class can the keel have further machining/ alterations carried out after it has been manufactured from a licenced pattern and still be class rule compliant?

**Answer:** No.

- Class rule E.2.1 is explicit in what can be done to the hull appendages which only covers repair and maintenance.
- If repaired or maintained it will still need to comply with the current class rules.
- Other types of work on the keel are prohibited.
