1 Isla de Vieques, Bahia Icacos northwards

Insert white + orange pillar buoys: **B** in 18°09'.4N 65°18'.5W **C** in 18°09'.7N 65°19'.6W (ILNW 568/08)

2 Isla de Vieques, east coast

The eastern end of Vieques was once a gunnery/bombing range. Mariners are warned that a contractor is currently employed to find and explode the unexploded ordinance, during which time yachts are required to keep clear.

Ensenada Honda to the west should be used as an alternative anchorage. (ILNW 65/10)

3 Isla de Vieques, Approaches to Esperanza (Main chart & inset)

The radio tower shown on the chart was destroyed in a hurricane and its replacement has been positioned slightly differently.

As a result, the transit line shown should not be used. Instead, mariners should just enter midway between Capo Real and Capo de Tierra. (ILNW 67/10)

4 Isla de Vieques, Esperanza (Inset)

The harbour at Esperanza has reportedly shoaled drastically and now has a least depth of around 9'. (ILNW 489/11)
