



RYA Sailability Volunteer Awards 2013 Nomination Guidelines

The RYA Sailability Awards recognise the priceless voluntary contribution given by people who make a real impact on our sport. These awards, seen as the 'MBEs' of our sport, will be given to volunteers involved in delivering sailing for disabled people at grass roots level.

Award Categories

Individuals can be nominated in one of three Award Categories. Each category of equal standing but reflects the different contributions people have made to our sport. The categories in 2013 are:

Exceptional Contribution - someone who has shown exceptional commitment and dedication over a period of 10 years or more

Outstanding Contribution – someone who has volunteered for less than 10 years but who has none the less made a significant contribution. This could be a single or 'one-off' contribution

Significant Contribution - someone who has demonstrated a regular commitment and/or inspirational contribution to the sport

Nomination Criteria

- 1. Nominations must be from an RYA Sailability Foundation Site, not normally an individual. Nominations will not be accepted from close family members.
- 2. A Foundation Site can make up to **three nominations**, one in each of the three categories in any given year. Each individual can only be nominated for an award in **one** category in any given year.
- 3. A person cannot normally receive more than one Award.
- 4. If the person being nominated for an Award, also has a 'paid role' or is 'employed' to undertake similar duties, they must also have given the equivalent service in a voluntary capacity. I.e. given significant time *in addition* to their paid work or employment.
- 5. Posthumous awards will not normally be made.
- 6. Successful nominations will need to clearly show how the individual has 'put something back' into the sport, and that this effort/contribution is above and beyond normal participation in activities.
- 7. Nominations will only be accepted on the RYA Sailability Awards nomination form (attached)
- 8. Where letters of support are attached they should be limited to only 2 per nomination, 1 page A4 (approx 500 words) in length, and typed if possible.
- 9. Nominations should reach RYA Sailability by Tuesday 8th January 2013.

Confidentiality

All nominations will be treated in the strictest confidence. The RYA suggests that you **do not** inform the nominee that you are putting them forward for an Award to avoid raising expectations which may not be met.

RYA Awards Panel

The Awards Panel will consider each nomination and their decision will be approved by 14th January 2013. This decision is final.

The RYA will endeavour to inform you and your nominee by January 18th 2013 if the nomination is successful.

If the nomination is unsuccessful the RYA will endeavour to inform you by January 23rd 2013. The RYA will not inform the nominee if the nomination is unsuccessful.

Presentation of Awards

Successful nominees will be invited to receive their Awards at the RYA Sailability National conference on Saturday 16th February 2013.

Conditions of Entry

All material submitted as part of any nomination and the copyright thereof shall become the property of the RYA. No nomination will be returned.

The RYA may, at its discretion, change the award category for which the nomination is made.

Only nominations received by Tuesday 8th January 2013 will be considered for the 2013 RYA Sailability Awards.

Submission of a nomination form to the RYA is deemed acceptance of these conditions and agreement to be bound by them.

The RYA reserves the right to change these conditions at any time by posting changes on the RYA website.
