

YOUTH CLASSES: OPTIMIST - SPLASH - CADET - 420 LASER RADIAL - LASER - LASER 4.7 - EUROPE

> JULY 02 - JULY 06, 2005 **NIEUWPOORT, BELGIUM**



The 17th Flanders Youth Regatta for: Optimist, Cadet, Splash, 420, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Laser and Europe classes will be held from July 02 to July 06, 2005 and will be sailed on the North Sea off the coast of Nieuwpoort, Belgium. The Flanders Youth Regatta is a part of the Nieuwpoortweek 2005.

2. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The KYCN, VVW and WSKLuM yacht clubs in Nieuwpoort are the organizers of the 17th Flanders Youth Regatta.

3. RULES

3.1 The 17th Flanders Youth Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008.

3.2 The prescriptions of the Belgian national authority will not apply.

3.3 Appendix P of the RRS 2005-2008 shall be applicable.

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee includes the official Flanders Youth Regatta polo-shirt, one ticket per competitor for the grand Barbecue and the Flanders Youth Regatta-party on Monday, and many daily social activities during the Regatta-week.

5. ENTRIES & ELIGIBILITY

- b. Eligibility Age limit:
- Optimist, Cadet, Splash: age limit requirements to comply with the Class Rules.
- 420, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Laser and Europe: under the age of 23 years in 2005.
- c. If there are less than 15 entries in a class by June 15, the Organisation Authority reserves the right to cancel the regatta for that class.
- d. If a class has 60 or more entries. the organising authorities may subdivide the class into different starting groups and use a round-robin system. Details of this system can be found in the Sailing Instructions.

6. SHORE LOCATIONS

Information and registration for all classes are in the Nieuwpoortweek Central Regatta Office (aka NPW Central Regatta Office).

7. CERTIFICATES

Each entered boat must have a valid measurement certificate as required by its National Authority and/or Class Rules.

8. INSURANCE

A valid third-party liability insurance must exist for each participating boat and may be checked at registration. If the insurance cannot be proven, the participant will be able to purchase a one-week policy.

10. SAILING AREA

There will be several race areas established for the Regatta. The Sailing Instructions will provide the necessary information about sailing areas and courses to be sailed for each class.

11. SCORING SYSTEM

The low-point scoring system appendix A of RRS will apply to all races. 12 races are scheduled of which 4 have to be completed to constitute a series.

12. TROPHIES AND PRIZES

The following overall prizes will be awarded:

The best overall boat in each class will receive EUR 150.

The second overall boat in each class will receive EUR 100.

The third overall boat in each class will receive EUR 50.

The first boat in each class with an all female crew will receive EUR 100. Several other trophies and prizes will also be awarded in the different classes.

There will be one trophy for 10 starters, two trophies for 20 starters, three trophies for 30 starters or more for each class.

13. INTERNATIONAL IURY

The organizers will appoint an International Jury. Its decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.4

14. ADVERTISING

The Flanders Youth Regatta will be governed by ISAF regulation 20 (ISAF Advertising Code).

Each competitor shall display on both sides of his hull the stickers from the event sponsors, supplied by the organisation as stated in regulation 20.3.1.(d) (i)

19. SAFETY

The wearing of adequate personal buoyancy devices by all participants is mandatory at all times while afloat. Each helmsman is obliged to carry the identification badge issued by the organizer upon registration, when she/he takes to the water. This identification badge shall be handed over to the Beach Master when leaving the slipway and shall be collected back from him immediately after the race.

A lost identification badge must be renewed and shall cost EUR 5.

20. TEAM LEADERS/COACHES

Team leaders and/or representatives will register at the NPW Central Regatta Office before the start of the first race and indicate their address during the Regatta. Each coach/team leaders boat shall fly a flag or have a sign on their boat of at least 50×50 cm with their country code.

All team leaders and/or representatives are invited to the team leaders meeting, which will be held on Saturday July 02 at 10.30 AM at the NPW Central Regatta Office and at the daily event and weather briefing at 08.30 AM.

21. BEHAVIOUR/MISCONDUCT

Sailing is a sport where courtesy and good manners are integral parts of the regatta experience.

During the Flanders Youth Regatta, especially during social events, incidents of misconduct or unsportsmanlike conduct will be reported to the International Jury.

- 3. RRS Fundamental Rule 4: A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or continue racing
- 4. I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event.
- 5. I hold and will produce a current measurement certificate for the above boat and membership of a National Class Association recognised by the International Class Association in order to qualify as a
- 6. I declare that I hold the valid certificate of insurance mentioned above, which also covers me whilst racing (including Third Party liability) which will be valid for the duration of the event. 7. I understand that if the boat is in the charge of any person other than the undersigned, it is the responsibility of the undersigned to bring to the attention of the person in charge of the boat the provisions of this entry form. In addition I will also make the crew aware of these undertakings.
- 8. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he or she is sailing.
