





Vision Trends

Africa	AGWM missionaries in Congo are starting Bible schools as a way to plant churches in the area. The Decade of Pentecost has a projected goal of seeing 10 million new believers baptized in the Holy Spirit and mobilized as Spirit-empowered witnesses.
Asia Pacific	Vietnam Bible College, partnering with Global University, has reached over 1000 students. Other groups are inquiring as to the possibility of partnering with Global University in providing Pentecostal training.
	Live Dead: Arab World is sending teams to 33 different cities over the next few years.
Eurasia	India plans to plant 25,000 churches in 10 years.
Europe	AGWM Europe is partnering with the Pentecostal European Mission's goal to see 200 viable ministries started among UPGs by 2020.
Latin America/Caribbean	Mexico's national church has 400 church planters ready to reach the UPGs in that country. Ecuador and Peru are training 1000–1500 people to start groups as a function of the church.
Northern Asia	Ecclesia Bible College and Global University programs have over 12,000 students enrolled, increasing at nearly 900 per month. The goal is 50,000 students over the short-term, with as many as 100,000 students eventually.
International Ministries	LIFE Publishers: Fire Bible is now in print in 40 language editions, with another 32 in development.
