Call for Submissions from Artists





Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council is delighted to invite submissions from artists who have studied in, are living in, working in or originally from Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown for a Visual Art Open Submission Exhibition to be held in the Concourse in County Hall, Dún Laoghaire from the 22nd February to 12th March 2013. A launch will take place on Thursday 21st February for selected artists and invited guests. dlr County Council will present an award of €1,000 to the overall winner of the Open Submission Exhibition and two runner up prizes of €250 each. The exhibition will be selected by Tara Murphy, Director of Solomon Fine Art, Dublin. Her decision shall be final. The exhibition is open to 2D and 3D work; please note that work in other formats (including digital) is not eligible.

Guidelines

- → All applications must include printed images of the work between the minimum size of 20cm x 15cm and maximum size of 30cm x 40cm. No original artworks are to be submitted
- ightarrow All artworks are to have been created in the last 3 years
- ightarrow All artworks must be original
- $\rightarrow\,$ All applications must be accompanied by the official application form
- → All applications must be accompanied by a cheque or postal order made out to Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council for €5.00
- → All applications must be accompanied by a 1 page CV detailing relevant experience
- → All applications must be accompanied by recommended display instructions (dlr Arts Office retains the right to decide on the final display)

- → There is a limit of three artworks per artist (one application form and fee per artist)
- ightarrow All applicants must be 16 years old or over
- $\rightarrow\,$ All artworks must be suitable for transportation and ready for exhibition
- ightarrow 2D works can be no larger than 230cm high (no width restriction)
- $\rightarrow\,$ 3D works can be no larger than 100cm wide and 200cm high
- ightarrow Please note that submissions will not be returned
- → Please note that dlr County Council is not in a position to handle sales of work from the exhibition; however contact details for exhibitors may be passed on to interested parties (subject to prior approval from the artist)
- → Selected artworks must be delivered to County Hall on Monday 18th February between 10am and 5pm
- → Artworks must be collected on Wednesday 13th March between 10am and 5pm. Please note that dlr County Council is not in a position to hold work in storage beyond this time
- → Artists will be responsible for transportation of accepted artworks to and from County Hall and for insurance of their work for the duration of the exhibition; dlr County Council will not be responsible for the insurance of any exhibited works
- $\rightarrow\,$ The closing date for entries is Thursday 10th January 2013 at 3.00pm. No late entries will be accepted.
