### **Let's get started.....**

**This treasure hunt commences from the steps outside the main door of Marlay House.**

**There are 18 clues in all and 25 photos to be taken, referenced as Picture 1-Picture 25 on the sheet.**

**There is a map after the clues. Stick to the route!**

#### **Clue 1:**

Picture the Courtyard from outside in  
That's your first photo, now wander in.

#### **Clue 2:**

For these 2 pictures you must take a look:

At the Beast on the Door  
And at the Sign of the Book

#### **Clue 3:**

Boland's House - well known for its tea.

Take a photo of it, show it to me.

Then into the gardens you must go for some more  
As that's where you'll find your clue number 4.

#### **Clue 4:**

A lion on a wall, Good luck on a door

A fountain of wishes, windows galore.

Chose 2 of these things and on your camera press click

For your next clue then head to the veggies quite quick.

**Clue 5:**

Little fingers be careful for fear of a peck  
But through your lens you can look - go on and check.

**Clue 6:**

The Veg Garden is resting for winter is near  
Find the tunnel and take a photo here.

**Clue 7:**

I may have a head, but no arms at all  
Picture me, I'm near the wall.

**Clue 8:**

Head out through Boland's House and turn right  
along a tree-lined path beside the big field you just might...  
....picture the path all covered in gold,  
Or look up at the sky – another scene to behold.

**Clue 9:**

Just right off the path is a house from times past  
Take a picture of it, let's hope it will last.

**Clue 10:**

Head back to your path, Turn right 'fore the bridge  
Follow the pond – you'll soon take an image  
This shelter on the pond has views across the water  
Take a photo here, then move on you ought to.

**Clue 11:**

Onwards again, beside the lake,  
Looking across at reflections - one scene you must take.

Two bridges, a stream, a tree with big roots,  
Will a shot of the waterfall win you the loot?

Onwards again as there's magic in store  
At the home you'll use your camera some more.

**Clue 14:**

Travel along past the tree with 3 trunks  
If you find it look up and another photo you've sunk

Continue along to a bridge over a 'fall beside a nice tree  
Stand near the water and show me all three.

Cross over that bridge, keep the stream on your right  
Over another twin bridge - any picture in sight?

Turn left at the road past some slides and an owl (not a grouse)  
Capture a path with a bend  
And the white, green-door'd house

Some sculpture awaits – stone, silver or black  
Take a photo of one, keep that in your pack.

And now in front - Marlay house you can see
