



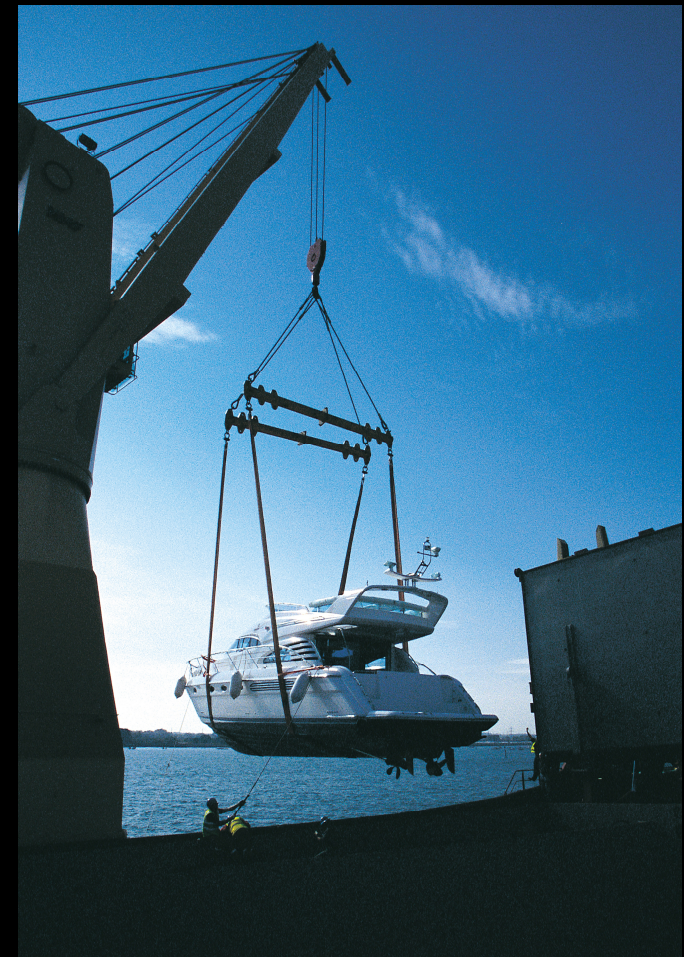

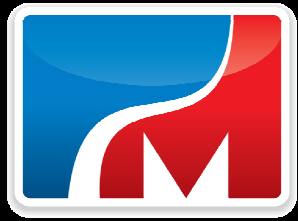
Do you know the **WEIGHT** of your boat?

### Weight or Displacement



**1 Metric Ton is equal to 1000 kilograms**



Your boat's weight or displacement, is a VITAL piece of information required by Peters & May. This should be the TOTAL WEIGHT of your boat, including her maximum fuel and water loads.



If you do not know the weight of your boat, you could do the following to find it:

- Consult your manufacturer's guide
- Organise for your boat to be weighted in a travel lift

### Gross Register Tonnage



One 'register ton' is equal to 100 cubic feet



Therefore the Gross Register Tonnage of your boat is NOT its WEIGHT, but the total volume of its internal space.



These volume measurements will be displayed on your boat's Registry Certificate, but are not required by Peters & May to ship your boat.

### Net Register Tonnage



The Net Register Tonnage is also a volume measurement and accounts for the volume of non-productive or cargo areas of your boat.
