 - **(Scotland Bill and Wales priorities)**
- Need for joined-up marine management –

 - **Conservation**

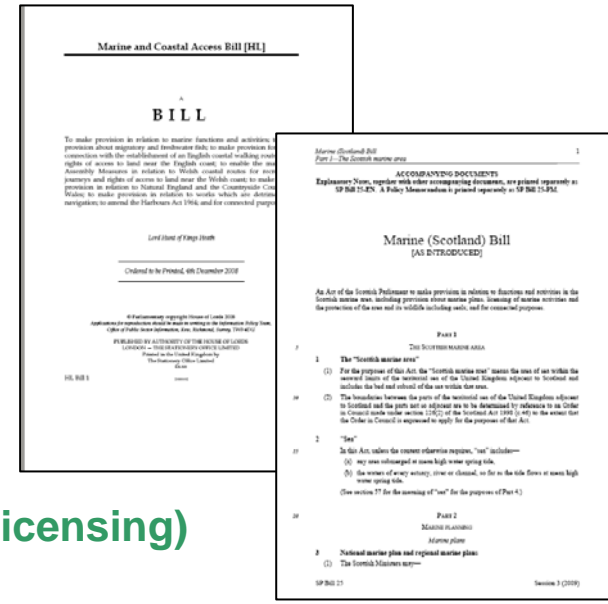
Northern Ireland Seas – small?

- Europe:
 - Marine Strategy Directive/GES
 - Water Framework Directive
- International (OSPAR, CBD)
- UK:
 - UK Marine & Coastal Access Bill (MPS/Licensing)
 - Scottish Marine Bill
- Practical need!
 - A real need in Northern Ireland for streamlined management – across sectors and across government

Current Situation

- UK Marine & Coastal Access Bill - 2009
- Scottish Marine Bill – 2009
 - UK-wide Marine Policy Statement
- Northern Ireland: Policy process leads us to 2012
 - So.....

What do we need?

- UK context –
 - Up to 2009 and after (Scotland, England & Wales): projects
 - Implementation of marine planning, MCZ networks, regional projects, MMOs
- NI implementation –
 - Legislative timetables not changeable?
 - So development of projects *vital*
 - *Thinking needed* – to get the policy right
