



To organise assistance to NOCs, particularly those with the greatest need of it, in order that NOCs may fulfil their responsibilities to the Olympic Movement.












OLYMPIC REVENUE SOURCES






OLYMPIC REVENUE DISTRIBUTION*






BROADCAST REVENUE DISTRIBUTION









Technical and financial assistance for athletes preparing for multisports or community Games

- Specificities for each continent
- Annual budget

YOG – ATHLETE SUPPORT



Support to NOCs to identify young talented athletes and help them to qualify for the YOG

- 3 options :
 - Identify
 - Qualify
 - Prepare



PROGRAMMES FOR COACHES



Qualified coaches Training strategy

- Technical Courses for Coaches
- Olympic Scholarships for coaches
- Development of National Sports Structure



TECHNICAL COURSES FOR COACHES



Basic training for officially recognised and active coaches

- Average duration: 10-15 days
- Basic level training (1 ou 2)
- Regional courses for higher-level activities



OLYMPIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COACHES



High-level further training in Centres or Universities for officially recognised and active coaches

- 2 options: sports sciences and sports specific training
- Average duration:1 to 3 months



DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL SPORTS STRUCTURE



Creation of medium- to long-term action plans (about 3 to 6 months)

- To strengthen all national sports and coaching structure
- Technical support from the IF and visits by an international expert



2009-2012 OS programmes to promote the development of Sailing and Olympism with the collaboration of the ISAF



- 35 scholarships (23 NOCs) 23 participated in London
 2012 Olympic Games (4 silver medals)
- 160 NOCs benefited from Continental/Regional Games
- 163 NOCs benefited from YOG related Assistance





- 25 technical courses organised (24 NOCs) (18 national & 7 regional)
- 17 scholarships for coaches through 15 NOCs (1 sport science & 16 sport specific ISAF Training Scholarships)
- 3 projects: Development of the National Sports Structure (3 NOCs)
