# NOTICE OF RACE

#### **VENUE**

Canadian 505 Fleet 1, in conjunction with Kitsilano Yacht Club will host the 2014 505 Canadian Championships as a part of the 2014 Kits Invitational Regatta. The club is located in the heart of Kitsilano in Vancouver's west side, walking distance to popular Kits Beach and a 5-10 minute drive to downtown Vancouver. Racing will be conducted in English Bay. The starting area will likely be no more than a 15-20 minute sail from the club.

#### **RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, including the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, and by the Class Rules of the International 505.

#### **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

The regatta is open to all boats of the International 505 class. Competitors must be members in good standing with their respective national class association.

#### **FEES**

Entry fees will be as per the Kits Invitational Regatta, plus an additional 10\$ Canadian (more information will be provided by May 2014).

#### **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be similar to or the same as issued for the Kits Invitational Regatta and will be available at registration.

2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. Both the top 505 competitor and the top Canadian finisher will be recognized.
