

NOTICE TO MARINERS M11 of 2014

NINE ELMS REACH BATTERSEA POWER STATION LIFTING OPERATIONS

On or about the 17th February 2014; for a period of approximately one week, contractors working on behalf of Battersea Power Station Development Company will commence foreshore clearance works behind Battersea Power Station Jetty.

The works will involve lifting operations from the Crane Barge SEABREEZE, and will involve men working close to the waterline. Whenever men are working close to the waterline during these works, London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed” as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2011. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed on Battersea Power Station Jetty during this period, and failure to do so will result in the termination of the broadcast. The safety boat ALFIE will also be in attendance and monitoring VHF Channel 14.

Persons in charge of vessels are to navigate with particular care and proceed according to the London VTS broadcasts when passing the works.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
