Cadet Open at Tamesis Club

Despite the strong stream the fleet got away cleanly in the first race with Jodok & Constantin Gerber (TC) first round the first mark. The fleet bunched on the long run against the stream and Alex Corby & Rob Keen (FGSC) finally broke away to lead round the leeward mark and held this all the way to the finish closely followed by Henry Marsh & Fredrick Collins (RLYC) in second and Jodok & Constantin in third.

After lunch race two once again started cleanly, Alex & Rob soon emerged from the pack closely followed by Jack Hardie & Megan Ferguson (Frensham) in second and Ross & John Thompson (Frensham) in third. These positions were maintained until the last lap when Alex & Rob had an incident with a boat they were lapping and were forced to do 720 allowing Jack & Megan through to win the race by 2 boat lengths from Alex & Rob with Ross & John in third.

This meant that going into the last race any one of three boats could win the event. Whoever from Alex & Rob, Jack & Megan and Henry & Fredrick won the last race would take home the cup. Leading away from the first mark were Henry & Fredrick with a good lead from Alex & Rob with Jack & Megan in third. Slowly the two chasing boats closed the gap over the next couple of laps and going into the final leeward mark all 3 boats rounded together. On the short beat to the finish Alex & Rob managed to gain a slight advantage and crossed the line less than a boat length ahead of Jack & Megan with Ross & John passing Henry & Fredrick in the final few yards to steal third.

This meant Alex & Rob won the event with Jack & Megan second and Henry & Fredrick third.
