Proposal

To adopt the NACRA 17 Class as an ISAF International Class Association.

Current Position

The new NACRA 17 was chosen by ISAF in May 2012 as a new Olympic Class.

Reason

 65 teams from 23 countries and 5 continents participated in the 2013 NACRA 17 World Championship.

(a) Active Class/Owner Association

The International NACRA 17 Class Association was formed in Spring 2013 and has a provisional management team in place, a working party (with sailors from all continents) and Executive Director (Class Manager). During the ISAF World Cup in Mallorca (March 2014) the Executive Committee will be elected.

(b) Class Constitution

The current NACRA 17 CLASS Constitution has been provided.

(c) Class Rules

The NACRA 17 Class Rules have been provided in ISAF format (closed rules).

(d) <u>Provided a list of register boat owners</u>

A list of supplied boat numbers is provided.

(e) Qualification Numbers

For ISAF Class status for a boat up to 6 m there is a minimum requirement of 15 boats in five MNAs from two continents.

The international distribution of the first 100 boats was organised by ISAF, accordingly there are currently not yet 5 countries with fleets of 15 or more boats.

(g) Application Fee

The ISAF Class Status application fee for the NACRA 17 Class has been paid.
