RYA Training 2014

- Step 1 Please read the terms and conditions page. By requesting a place on the course you will also be accepting these terms and conditions. Please also read the attached parental consent form. You are not required to complete or return this at this stage but you will be asked to sign this, where appropriate, on the first morning of the course and be prepared to follow the terms.
- **Step 2.** Read the course programme and work out which courses you would like to be on.
- **Step 3** Complete the booking form giving as much information as possible. This information will help with the decision as to the candidates' suitability for the requested courses. Please complete one booking form for each candidate.

Booking Terms and Conditions

By making a booking it will be deemed that you have read and agreed with these terms and conditions.

1. Payment for training courses

Once we have accepted your application onto the course we will request a payment for the full amount of the course (payment details will be supplied). If you choose to cancel the course up to 4 weeks before the start of the course a refund of 75% will be made. If you choose to cancel the course within four weeks of the start of the course a refund of 50% will be made. If you choose to cancel the course with 7 days of the start date no refund will be made. In all these events, if you can find a suitable candidate who can take up the space on the booked course then this would require no further payment.

2. Frensham Pond Sailing Club Cancellation

FPSC reserves the right to cancel any course and will attempt to reschedule the course. If this is not possible a full refund will be made. Any student exhibiting anti-social or disruptive behaviour could be asked to leave the course.

3. Loss or Accidents

FPSC cannot be held responsible for any accident to students or for loss or damage to their possessions whilst using the facilities at FPSC. All cars and personal possessions left at FPSC are at the owner's risk.

In addition, a condition of our insurance is to make you aware of the following statement: "RYA/NSSA Instructors, NSSA Sailing Masters, RYA Senior Instructors or RYA Coaches do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury suffered by persons and/or their property arising out of or during the course of their activities whilst training and/or coaching and/or instructing, unless such injury, loss or deliberate act was caused by, or resulting from negligence or deliberate".

4. Photography

In accordance with our child protection policy and RYA guidelines, (See www.rya.org.uk) any photographs or video images taken will be used solely for coaching/training, recognising achievement or promoting club events by publishing photographs in club newsletters, websites, local newspapers etc. No personal information, other than the child's name will be included with a photograph or video image.

5. Health Warning

(A) Weil's Disease is a bacterial infection carried in rat's urine that contaminates water and wet riverbanks. The bacteria do not survive for long in dry conditions. It can be a serious illness requiring hospital treatment, and can lead to kidney or liver failure. Weil's Disease is a notifiable illness. The bacteria are absorbed through the skin or mucous membranes of the mouth and eyes. It gets into the blood stream very easily if you have a minor cut on your skin or feet, should you become immersed. If you feel ill after training or have any of the following symptoms, call your doctor promptly. The most common early symptoms are high temperature, an influenza-type illness and muscle pains. Tell your doctor that you have been undertaking water activities at Frensham and ask if you can have a blood test for Weil's disease.

(B) Certain species of the blue-green algae can produce toxins, which, upon contact, may cause a number of conditions such as dermatitis, asthma, eye irritation, rashes, blistering of the skin around the mouth and nose, nausea, gastroenteritis, muscle cramps, headaches and pneumonia in some people.





For children under the age of 16 taking part in RYA training at the Club we require that the parent either stays on-site or signs the authority below. This authority gives the Senior Instructor/Chief Instructor the right to act in loco parentis in your absence.

By signing this consent form you agree that:

- (a) The parent/guardian will be on-site at the club until the course has officially started and return 15 minutes before the end of the course.
- (b) The parent/guardian will sign a form at the beginning of each course giving the Senior Instructor or Chief Instructor parental responsibility for their child/children in their absence.
- (c) During the running of a formal RYA training course the RYA Senior instructor or Chief Instructor in charge of the specific course will act in loco parentis for the children on that course.
- (d) The RYA Senior Instructor, Chief Instructor or Principal reserves the right to remove a child from the course at any time.
- (e) Children must not be removed from the club during a course without informing the senior instructor.
- (f) The parent/guardian will be available to return and collect the child within 30 minutes of being contacted by the club. The parent/guardian must remain contactable and available whilst the child/children are at the club.

If you do not agree to the above rules we would ask that you remain at the Club whilst the training is taking place.
