 in any doubt please contact us.
- 2. The minimum age for all of the courses is 18.
- 3. The full fee must be paid at the time of booking. **We do not accept provisional bookings.**Bookings will only be confirmed once we have received your application form and payment.
- 4. Balance of fees is due 5 weeks before the start date of the course. If the balance of payment is not received at this time we reserve the right to re-sell the course. Bookings made within 5 weeks of the course start date must be paid in full.
- 5. The fee for revalidation and reassessment must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- 6. Cancellation by the Applicant. If more than 5 weeks notice is given, 25% of the full course fee will be retained by the RYA as a cancellation fee. If notice is given less than 5 weeks before the start of the course, we will make every effort to fill your place. In the event the space remains unsold you remain liable for the full amount. The course fee cannot be refunded for any reason once the course has been started.
- 7. Cancellation by the RYA. The full course fee, including deposit will be returned. The RYA will not be liable under any circumstances for any cost or loss incurred as a result of its failure to conduct a particular instructor course. The RYA reserves the right to cancel any course in the event of equipment failure or otherwise.
- 8. By booking on a course run by the RYA, you are accepting these booking conditions.
- 9. The RYA reserves the right to refuse to grant an instructor qualification to a candidate should that candidate have a restriction imposed on their commercial endorsement by the MCA.
