

MAINTENANCE ON BOARD LORD NELSON AND TENACIOUS

LORD NELSON and TENACIOUS are maintained to a high standard, in order to meet the safety requirements of Lloyds Register of Shipping and the Maritime and Coastguard Agency. The majority of our maintenance is carried out by volunteers who give up some of their free time to help on board during the year, both in the UK and abroad.

The working day is from approximately 0830 – 1630 hours. We provide breakfast, lunch and supper, together with a tea break morning and afternoon, and a complementary tot from the bar at the end of the working day. You are also welcome to stay on board free of charge if you wish.

We always need Engineers, Carpenters, Electricians and Riggers, so if you have any specific skills please let us know. However the main skills required are enthusiasm and the willingness to get involved. The tasks are many and varied including painting, varnishing, cleaning, and helping in the galley.

It is an opportunity to learn new skills, meet new people and if you have not sailed with the JST before, a real chance to get to know the ships and hopefully be encouraged to join us on a voyage in the future.

All you need to bring with you is:

- Bed sheet, duvet cover, pillow case and towel (please ensure these are clean), but not sleeping bags. (Bedding not required for overseas maintenance, but please bring towel)
- Working clothes (boiler suits and safety boots can be provided on board, but please bring your own if you have them)
- Clothes for going out in the evening, if you wish to

Things to be aware of:

- Each day we have two safety briefings, at 0830 and 1330; you will not be able to undertake
 any work until your briefing has been completed. If you would like an evening meal onboard
 you will need to attend the 1330 briefing at the latest.
- ALL maintainers will be required to take part in the galley mess-man rota, irrespective of their special skills and will be required to take part in Happy-Hour (ship cleaning) on the occasions they are held.
- Bar hours will be from "Tot Time" to 23:00 but will only open for soft drink/snacks at lunchtime.
- Parking in the port may be limited/insecure
- Depending on the location/security of the berth you may be required to do an occasional night watch
- When ever possible please arrive before 8pm.
