## About the Jubilee Sailing Trust


The JST is a charity that promotes the integration of people of all physical abilities, through the challenge and adventure of tall ship sailing aboard two very special ships, Lord Nelson and Tenacious.

They are the only two ships of their kind in the world that have been designed and built to enable people of all physical abilities to sail side by side on equal terms.

Facilities on board both ships include wheelchair lifts between deck levels, a hearing loop, a speaking compass and hydraulic power-assisted steering.

Since its founding in 1978, the JST has taken 40,000 people to sea, 15,000 of which were physically disabled, including 5,000 wheelchair users.

A voyage with the JST can be a life-changing experience where adventure, challenge and friendships come together.


