What Is DutyMan?

Highcliffe Sailing Club uses a system called *DutyMan* for the publication and management of race duties. *DutyMan* is an online system which allows members to check for duties which have been allocated to them, and organise duty swaps if necessary.

Swapping duties online

If you need to swap duties then the preferred method is to use *DutyMan*. *DutyMan* is the reference for all duties that have been assigned and should be used to make any changes. To access *DutyMan* go to "club" tab on the website and you will find it in the menu selection

To facilitate a smoother running duty roster for racing in 2011, we have changed the way in which it will operate this year. We will no longer have team leaders and will instead rely on the OOD to ensure that they have a full team available for their day's duties.

If you are an OOD, your team will still have been notified in the normal way via the dutyman system. However you may wish to e-mail or ring your team to confirm their availability (These details are all available on Dutyman)

If you find that one of your team is unable to make their duty and you cannot achieve a swop then please contact the Sailing Secretary (Details below)

If you are not an OOD, and unable to make a duty, it is your responsibility to either swap within dutyman or contact your OOD, giving adequate time to allow the OOD to find a replacement.
