

Frequently Asked Questions

Q My ticket(s)/admittance card(s) are incorrect – what do I do?
 A Please send them back to us – Gulliver House, Madeira Walk, Windsor

SL4 1EU – marked for the attention of Anna Wing. Please include a covering note explaining what changes need to be made.

- If it is about a week before the presentation we will send you new tickets.
- If it is very close to the presentation day, tickets will be left at the door.
 We will let you know if this is the case. You should then inform the
 Police and a member of DofE staff on the door of this when you arrive.

Q Where is the nearest train station?

A The nearest overground station is London Victoria. The nearest tubes are Green Park (Jubilee/Piccadilly/Victoria) and St James's Park (District/Circle).

Q Is there any car parking at the Palace?

A There is no car parking at the Palace. The are plenty of car parks around. Just use the St James's Palace postcode SW1A 1BJ to search on www.ncp.co.uk

Q Are there any hotels nearby?

A Yes plenty, this is the centre of London! Type in "London Hotels" into a web search – it will come up with lots! You can book good rates through websites like lastminute.com or expedia.co.uk.

Q Have you had any cancellations / can I bring another guest?

A We always book presentations that take us to the limit in the Palace, so sorry, you cannot bring another guest.

Q How long does the presentation last?

A The presentation takes approximately 2½ hours from start to finish. Morning presentations will finish around 13.00.

Afternoon presentations will finish around 17.30.

Q Is there a cloakroom?

A Yes, but it is for coats / umbrellas **only**.

Q What can I bring (camera / mobile phone / overnight bag)?

A If you bring a camera and/or mobile phone, they should be left switched off in a bag/pocket. If you are seen using them, they will be confiscated – this includes cameras on mobile phones! You can use your camera outside the Palace only.

Nothing larger than a lady's handbag is allowed into the Palace. If you have overnight bags, they should be left in the hotel or at a train station in the left luggage area.

Q My letter says one time and my tickets say another, which one is right?

A The letter only gives an approximate start time. The actual arrival time – which is indicated on the admittance card – depends on the State Apartment you are in. The tickets give the correct arrival time.

Q I've missed the train en-route to the Palace / am stuck in traffic etc – what should I do?

A If you are not going to be in time for your presentation – the time you need to be in position on your entry card – please call us on 07730 651376.

Q Photographs – what is taken and where?

A The group photograph is taken in the Palace and the family / individual photographs are taken at a nearby studio location.

Q What is the group photograph?

A The group photograph is of the small group that you are in to receive your certificate (approximately 30 people). It is taken in the Palace.

Q What can my other guests do in London while I'm at the presentation?

A St James's Palace is in the centre of London, so there are museums, restaurants, shops, coffee shops, attractions etc. which your guests can go to.

Q What identification do I need?

A You are required to bring 2 forms of ID – one photographic (Passport or Driving Licence) and one other form of ID with your address on (utility bill/bank statement etc).

Q I'm ill or my guest is ill on the day/day before – what should I do?

A If your guest is ill, it's too late to change the guest, so you can either come alone to the Palace, or defer to a different presentation (either in the Spring or Autumn, depending on when they fall). If you want to defer, please send the tickets back with a letter telling us that. If it's really close to the presentation or on the day and you are not going to attend please email us on gap@DofE.org or on the day call 07730 651376.

Q I can't come – what should I do?

A Send the tickets back with a letter stating whether you want to attend a future presentation, or receive the certificate by post. If it's really close to the presentation/on the day and you are not going to attend please email us on gap@DofE.org or on the day call 07730 651 376.

Q What do I wear?

A Hats are optional. Trouser suits are very acceptable, as well as skirt suits or dresses. Basically anything that is smart (no jeans).

If you are coming in a uniform, that is also very acceptable – if it's military, please find out from your Commander which uniform is correct.

Q What facilities are there for disabled guests?

A Disabled guests can be dropped off in the street outside St James's Palace. If you cannot wait in the queue, please make yourself known to the Police. There is a lift inside the Palace to take you to the right floor. Wheelchairs cannot be provided.

Any problems, please ask a member of staff on the day.


