

Means Testing Amounts 2012-13

APAs are subject to "means testing". This means that any other income you may be receiving is taken into account in calculating your award. If your other income plus the maximum APA for your performance level is greater than the means testing threshold (£65,163 for 2011/12) your APA will be reduced by the excess amount. You must declare all other income received each time you complete an APA application form.

Table 2 details the amount of additional income a Podium level athlete can earn, over and above the APA, before the APA is reduced pound for pound. For 2012/13 the income disregard threshold is £65,163.
