 Harder for trainees 	Simpler for trainees






UMPIRES' ROUTE ROUND THE COURSE: T3, S Course








UMPIRES' ROUTE ROUND THE COURSE: T4, S Course













Positioning Golden Rules

- Get ahead! Get there early
- Drive straight to windward, cut corners
- Turn away not towards
- If stationary, point in direction of next travel
- If out of position, adjust **now** & **quickly**
- Accelerate when outside at mark, decelerate or stop when inside
- Be closer; anticipate
- Stretch vs contract; Mind the Gap!
