



Child Protection – Guidance Notes for Spectators

Young athletes are impressionable and their behaviour will often reflect that of the adults around them. *Pentathlon GB* welcomes spectators who embrace the ethos of the game as one of Fun, Enjoyment and Skill Development.

Spectators are encouraged to:

- 1. Be familiar with the rules of Modern Pentathlon.
- 2. Be familiar with, and abide by, the *Pentathlon GB* Child Protection Policy.
- 3. Act as positive role models to all young players.
- 4. Acknowledge effort and good performance rather than the "win at all costs" ethic.
- 5. Verbally encourage all youngsters in a positive way.
- 6. Encourage all youngsters irrespective of their ability
- 7. Remember children play sport for their enjoyment not yours.
- 8. Acknowledge good individual and team performance from ALL youngsters irrespective of which team they represent.
- 9. Respect match official's decisions.

Spectators should never:

- Use bad language, rude behaviour and violence.
- Verbally abuse young players, match officials, fellow spectators or coaches
