In response to your recent request I am writing to confirm that the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) accepts RYA training for Yachtmaster Ocean and Yachtmaster Offshore as acceptable pathways towards the issue of UK Certificates of Competency for Master 200gt.

The MCA also accepts RYA training as being suitable for skippers of UK registered vessels operating under the harmonised codes of practice for small commercial vessels (less than 24m registered length).

The full range of RYA training courses accepted by the MCA is contained in the attached list.

As a provider of training which may lead to the issue of a UK Certificate of Competency the RYA is subject to periodic audits by the MCA.
