



Introduction to CSPro

U.S. Census Bureau, Washington, D.C.

This workshop will present the main components of CSPro (Census and Survey Processing System). Participants will learn to design and implement data entry, batch editing, and tabulation applications to process census and survey data. Participants will also learn about ways to manage data and export data for use in other statistical software.

The workshop focuses on processing a population census or demographic survey, but participants are encouraged to bring any census or survey questionnaire relevant to their job responsibilities. The workshop is conducted in a hands-on, product-oriented environment. Each participant will have exclusive use of a computer and will receive the latest version of CSPro software.

Audience and Prerequisites

This is an introductory workshop oriented toward subject-matter specialists (such as demographers, economists, and sociologists), computer programmers, and IT professionals who wish to use CSPro to implement census and survey data processing systems, or who wish to understand this process in some detail. No previous experience using CSPro is required although experience using scripting languages is desirable. Participants must be comfortable working with Windows-based software.
