How to get there

- Located off A30, M25 junction 13 or M4 junction 6.
- 15 minute drive from Windsor town centre. Follow the brown tourist road signs.
- For sat navs, please use postcode TW20 0XD and note that access to The Savill Garden is only available through public roads.
- Egham and Windsor Riverside stations are on the direct line into Waterloo. Taxis are available from the train stations.

Virginia Water

Car park opens from 7.30am.

The Pavilion at Virginia Water offers refreshments, toilet facilities and a picnic lawn with sweeping views of the lake. Open from 8am.
