

GARMIN SAFE HARBOR PRIVACY POLICY

Garmin International, Inc. (“Garmin”) created this Safe Harbor Privacy Policy to tell you how we handle Personal Information that is collected by our affiliates in the European Economic Area and Switzerland (collectively the “EEA”) and transferred to Garmin in the United States. This Safe Harbor Privacy Policy supplements Garmin’s Privacy Policy and unless specifically defined in this Policy, the terms in this Policy have the same meaning as in Garmin’s Privacy Policy (<http://www.garmin.com/en-US/legal/privacy-statement>).

Garmin complies with the U.S. – E.U. Safe Harbor framework and the U.S. - Swiss Safe Harbor framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of personal data from European Union member countries and Switzerland. Garmin has certified that it adheres to the Safe Harbor Privacy Principles of notice, choice, onward transfer, security, data integrity, access, and enforcement. Personal Information Received From the EEA

Garmin may receive information from its affiliates in the EEA, including name, mailing address, phone number, email address, and credit card information (collectively, “Personal Information”).

Use of Personal Information

Any Personal Information sent to Garmin may be used for the purposes indicated in Garmin’s Privacy Policy. If we intend to use your information for a purpose that is incompatible with these purposes or if we intend to disclose it to a type of third party not previously identified, we will notify you and offer you the opportunity to opt out of such uses and/or disclosures where it involves non-sensitive information or opt in where sensitive information is involved.

Service Providers

We may use third party service providers to help us operate our business and websites or administer activities on our behalf, such as fulfilling purchases, processing payment card payments and shipping products to you. We may share Personal Information about you, including payment card information, with these third parties to enable them to perform the services. Garmin requires that service providers that have access to Personal Information received from the EEA either (a) subscribe to the Safe Harbor Privacy Principles, (b) are subject to applicable EEA data protection laws, (c) or enter into a written agreement with us that requires them to provide at least the same level of privacy protection as is required by the relevant Safe Harbor Principles.

Data Security

We use reasonable physical, electronic, and administrative safeguards to protect your Personal Information from loss, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

Data Integrity

We take reasonable steps to ensure that Personal Information we process is reliable for its intended use, accurate, complete, and current to the extent necessary for the purposes for which we use the Personal Information.

Access to Personal Data

You can ask to review and correct Personal Information that we maintain about you by sending a written request in accordance with the contact information listed below.
