Offshore in and around the UK

- Focus on the English Channel
- Need for accurate course planning, particularly tides
- Tricks of the tide near the French coast
- Approaching marks
- Weather forecasting safe havens, delaying the starts, etc





- Around the cans focus on the Solent
- Think like a navigator!
- Effects of tide which way to round marks
- Other classes also rounding removing conflicts
- Depth of water state of tide!
- Reaching versus running legs
- Rocky versus sandy sea bottoms
- Coming off the shore on port tack!
