

## **RYA/DofE Qualification Requirements**



There are no requirements for RYA Centre staff teaching DofE groups or individuals to hold DofE qualifications, <u>unless they are acting in a specific DofE role</u>, however we would suggest you consider taking relevant courses to ensure you have a good level of knowledge and understanding for the DofE Award.

Whenever running activity that falls under RYA Recognition, you must ensure you abide by RYA Recognition Guidelines, using suitable instructors holding appropriate RYA qualifications and following required ratios.

When acting as an assessor or supervisor you must ensure you hold the necessary DofE and RYA qualifications.

Supervisor	Supervisors are people with a <b>good understanding</b> of a participant's chosen activity. 	Expedition: A Supervisor is essential for the Expedition section as they are responsible for supervising and supporting a team of participants to ensure their safety and well-being whilst they are doing their expedition. Assessor* <sup>2</sup>	Assessors monitor a young person's progress and agree the completion of a section of their programme. You'll need knowledge of the activity they're doing and approve their progress and pictures in eDofE. Award Verifier	DofE Award Verifiers grant final approval to the Awards achieved by participants. <sup>\*2</sup> The Assessor should come from outside the centre especially for the expedition. At Bronze and Silver level expeditions, Assessors should not have been involved in any training or instruction of the team. At Gold level expeditions, the Assessor must be independent of the DofE group and not associated with the team in any way.
