Clarification of UIM rulings in the following areas have been received:

- > Saddle brackets can be strengthened by adding additional metal to the brackets.
- Solid mounts may be fitted as UIM Rules state mounts are free.
- Sensors may not be disconnected or removed but may be repaired.
- > 2015 3A World Championships confirmed in Oskarshamn, Sweden alongside 3B/C in on 1 5 July.
