

Converting from Yachtmaster Instructor (Power) to Powerboat Instructor

A Yachtmaster Instructor (Power) may attend a one-day assessment / conversion course to gain the Powerboat Instructor certificate.

Candidates should have suitable experience and be a competent boat handler in a variety of small boats.

The assessment will be carried out by a Powerboat Trainer and does not require moderation.

Candidates will be tested on their boat handling skills, knowledge of the Powerboat scheme and should be familiar with the current syllabus in the Powerboat logbook G20.

Successful candidates will be able to teach up to RYA Powerboat Level 2 certificate. If the instructor also holds the Safety Boat Certificate, they may also teach the Safety Boat Course.

Unsuccessful candidates may be given an action plan to complete before reassessment or be advised to take the full three day powerboat instructor course.
