Regulation 18.16.1

A submission from the Deutscher Segler Verband

Proposal:

- 1. The Council is requested to reconsider whether the amount of the Payment for International Umpires under Regulation 18.16.1 is still appropriate.
- 2. The Council is requested to reconsider whether it is appropriate to change the currency in Regulation 18.16.1 from US\$ into € (alternatively into GB Pound)

Current Position:

Payment for Umpires

18.16.1 For Graded Match Racing Events, the following fees apply:

- (a) ISAF Match Racing World Championships and Grade 1 Events US\$100 per race day + US\$200 for each International Umpire US\$150 per race day + US\$300 for the Chief Umpire
- (b) Grade 2 5 Events

For events with:

Cash or cashable prizes, appearance payments, individual sponsorship payments by the event organizers or otherwise, any/or other benefits of a similar nature totalling more than US\$20,000 or the equivalent, the following fees apply:

US\$100 per race day + US\$200 for each International Umpire US\$150 per race day + US\$300 for the Chief Umpire

- (c) The ISAF Executive Committee may adjust the fees under special circumstances.
- (d) When a Women's Grade 1 or 2 Match Racing event is combined with an Open Match Racing Grade 1 or 2 event then the event fees payable to the umpires include all race days of the combined event.*

Reason:

Proposal 1

1. Match Racing has developed in the grade 1 events to a professional sport. Because of this also the umpires must have the same professional level as the competitors. Therefore umpires need to be paid accordingly and appropriate.

- 2. With the current payment nobody can be attracted to become a professional umpire. Especially younger people who are still in business cannot afford to become professional umpires because the income is much too less to live on it.
- 3. With the current payment only those can afford to umpire professionally who have other income.
- 4. The umpire payment is still the same as it was implemented many years ago. But all living costs have increased in the meantime tremendously.
- 5. Because all of these circumstances the Council shall reconsider the amount of the umpire payment

Proposal 2

- 1. Most of the events to which 18.16.1 refers are held in the €-zone.
- 2. Most of the IUs live in the €-zone.
- 3. Only fewer events take place, and only fewer IUs live in the US\$-zone.
- 4 If the Umpire Payment shall not be in €-currency than only the GB-Pound is the appropriate currency, because ISAF is seated in the GB-Pound zone.
