3.3 COURSES

3.3.1 The course for the first offshore race is:

Waypoint Gate One is comprised of two waypoints, WG1(P) and WG1(S) described using the WGS84 Datum.

3.6 THE FINISH

- 3.6.3 Line Bravo bears 000° magnetic for 0.1nm from Darling Associates (see Addendum A)
- 3.6.6 For Finish lines Alpha, Bravo and Delta, a committee vessel may be on station at the end of the line and will be displaying a RORC blue flag with white seahorse, crown and border (or a fixed blue light at night). Boats shall pass between the buoy and the committee vessel.
- 3.6.7 If a committee vessel is not on station boats shall cross the line not more than 0.1nm from the finish buoy and promptly report their finishing time to the Regatta Headquarters by text message (+44 (0) 7825 007 035).
