DECISION

1 Background

- 1.1 On 2 June 2015 we decided that there is no evidence of gross misconduct by Mr. Chris Atkins and that there is no case for him to answer. We further invited Mr. Atkins and Mr. Peter Huston, the complainant, to make representation by 5 June 2015 whether the decision should be published to the general public or not.
- 1.2 Mr Atkins adopted a neutral stance. Mr. Huston did not respond.

2 Reasoning

- 2.1 The Disciplinary Commission Rule of Procedure 13.2 states that decisions of the Panel shall be public, except that the Panel may determine that its decision shall not be published and remain confidential if it believes there is good reason to do so.
- 2.2 There is no good reason why this decision should not be published.

3 Decision

3.1 The Panel's decision of 2 June 2015 and this decision shall be public and may be published to the general public.
