



2015 ISAF Youth Worlds Emerging Nations Programme







Aims:

- More nations attending the ISAF Youth Sailing World Championships (80 Nations in 2015).
- Emerging nations to come to the Youth Worlds event better prepared and for the 'performance gap' between nations to be reduced.
- Post-event monitoring of sailors and provision of access for them and their coaches to on-going support through the following year's YW ENP.
- Support to sailors who will be in-eligible for future YW ENP projects due to age, via the 2018 ISAF Sailing World Championship ENP or the IOC Olympic Solidarity Youth Olympic Games / Olympic Games Athlete Scholarship applications.


- Development of the training programme for all Coaches / Sailors

YW ENP - Activity overview:





Eligibility of participating nations:

The criteria for evaluation will be based on, but not limited to the following:

- Total attendance at the ISAF Youth Worlds event over the previous 4 years.
 Those attending all of the last 4 YW events will be required to fulfil alternative eligibility criteria in order to be considered.
- MNAs completing YW APP funding applications for support of attendance at 3 or fewer Youth Worlds events in the last 4 years will be eligible.
- Allocation of 2006 2014 IODA development funds will equal eligibility.
- Non-attendance at 2014 IODA and/or Laser World Championships will result in eligibility.





Eligibility criteria continued......

- Non-existence of formally identified national youth sail training programmes will result in eligibility.
- Application for IOC Olympic Solidarity funded programmes (Coaches / Sailors) at least once in the last 4 years will result in eligibility
- ISAF MNA / Associate Member status gained within the last 4 years will result in eligibility.
- MNAs will be eligible if they have benefitted from Youth Olympic Games Athlete Scholarship for one or more sailors at the last YOG event.
- Attendance at the 2014 ISAF Sailing World Championships through the S14 Emerging Nations Programme will result in eligibility.





ISAF Supported Costs

Regional YW ENP Performance Clinics

- Development of the training programme syllabus for all Clinics
- Costs of ISAF Nominated Experts to deliver Clinics
- Travel subsidies for up to 3 Sailors and 1 Coach per MNA to attend clinics.
- Provision of accommodation / food and practical equipment for all sailors and coaches

YW event in Langkawi, Malaysia

- Subsidies for event registration fees (including food and accommodation) as well as travel costs for all YW ENP Scholarship holders (sailors).
- Dedicated ISAF / WYST Coaching support on and off the water

Next steps...

- ISAF is working closely with MNAs that will host the 5 proposed YW ENP Regional Performance Clinics (below) and an announcement of full details is planned for mid-February:

Oceania: Fiji (24-30 April)

Africa: Mozambique (9-15 May) Europe: Hungary (16-22 May) Americas: Antigua (14-21 July) Asia: Malaysia (24-30 October)

- Once the YW ENP information is released to all MNAs, those wishing to take part in the 2015 YW ENP Performance Clinics should contact ISAF to request registration information for the clinics.
- ISAF will review applications and contact all eligible MNAs with confirmation of their registration on the relevant regional clinic.
