 Founded: October 30, 1897 as the North American Yacht Racing Union (NAYRU).









- <u>Vision</u>: Be the recognized leader in training and certification, in support for the racing sailor and in facilitating access to sailing.






Keelboat Certification System

- 73 accredited schools
- Adult focused education
- 3 of 5 largest schools in US included
- Student & Instructor certification levels ranging from Basic Keelboat to Offshore Passage Making.
- Offer International Proficiency Certificate



Reach-Science through Sailing


- Reach teaches Science, Technology,



Training Department Structure




Keelboat schools can only offer US Sailing student level certifications after completing accreditation review.
