NOTICE OF RACE

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Aim of the regatta: Awarding Hungarian Laser Class Fleet Champion titles to senior

and youth sailors, international qualifying regatta.

1.2. Venue and time: Balatonfüred, 17-19 June 2014.

1.3. Participating classes: Laser Standard, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7

1.4. Factor number: 1.2

2. ORGANISATION

2.1. Organising Authority: MVM Sailing Club, in cooperation with the Hungarian Laser Class

Association and the Hungarian Yachting Association

2.2. Principal Race Officer: Benedek Fluck2.3. Jury Chairman: Bence Böröcz

3. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016), the Hungarian General Sailing Instructions 2014, the Regatta Regulations, the Advertising Regulations of the Hungarian Yachting Association, the International Laser Class rules and this Notice of Race.

If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

4. ADVERTISING

Participating boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

5. ENTRY

5.1. Pre Entry

Pre-Entries shall be submitted by completing the entry form and sending it to info@mvmse.hu until 8 June 2014. Entry forms shall be downloaded from http://www.mvmse.hu/VitorlasSzakosztaly/ Late entries may be submitted until the on-site registration deadline.

Entry fee shall be paid by bank transfer to the following account:

Entry fee shall be paid in cash as well during the on-site registration at the Regatta Office.





5.2. Entry fee

The entry fee in case of pre-entry will be:

7 000 HUF/competitor or 23,5 EUR/competitor (Competitors born on or after 1 January 1996 pay 3.600 HUF/competitor or 12 EUR/competitor).

The entry fee in case of late entry will be:

8 000 HUF/competitor or 27 EUR/competitor (Competitors born on or after 1 January 1996 pay 4 000 HUF/competitor or 13,5 EUR/competitor).

5.3. Place and time of on-site registration

Place of registration: Regatta Office, Koloska Marina (8230, Kouvola u. 1. Balatonfüred). Time of registration: 16 June 2014 18.00-21.00 hrs and 17 June 2014 07.30-08.30 hrs.

6. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS, SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 6.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the Regatta Office of Marina Koloska.
- 6.2. Signals made ashore will be displayed at the main flagpole of the club located in the port.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1. There are eight (8) races scheduled for the regatta.
- 7.2. On the first two days three (3) races per day, on the last day two (2) races per day are scheduled.

9. CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be flags with the class insignias on the following backgrounds

Laser Standard: white background Laser Radial: green background Laser 4.7: yellow background

10. RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 10.1. The racing area will be among Balatonfüred, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany. Trapezoid courses will be sailed; the diagram in the Attachment shows the courses and the order in which marks are to be passed.
- 10.2. Marks 1, 1A,2 in case they do not constitute gates shall be left to port, marks 3s and 3p, as well as 4s and 4p will constitute gates at the end of the first downwind legs. In case of a missing gate mark, the remaining mark shall be left to port.
- 10.3. Each boat shall return to the starting area, as soon as possible after finishing, in order to start the following race.

11. MARKS

- 11.1. Marks will be yellow, cylindrical inflated buoys.
- 11.2. Starting and finishing marks are marks with striped flags.

12. OFFICIAL BOATS

- 12.1. Race Committee boats will be marked with an RC flag.
- 12.2. Jury boats will be marked with a JURY flag.
- 12.3. Press boats will be marked with a PRESS flag.
- 12.4. Non-official boats may only enter the racing area to perform their rescue duty.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42 will apply.

14. SCORING

Number of excluded races according to the number of completed races:

Completed races	Excluded races
1-4	0
5-8	1

At least two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute the Fleet Championship.

15. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY, PRIZES

- 15.1. Prize giving ceremony will be held after the last race, exact time and place will be posted on the official notice board.
- 15.2. The prizes will be given to the overall top three boats and to the first boat of each category in Laser Standard and Laser Radial classes, and to the top three boats of each category in Laser 4.7 class.





15.3. Competitors are divided and scored in the following categories:

Laser Standard Rig: Overall, Boys Under 21 (born 1994-95), Boys Under 19 (born 1996-97), Masters (born before 1979)

Laser Radial Rig Female: Overall, Girls Under 21 (born 1994-95), Girls Under 19 (born 1996-97), Girls Under 17 (born 1998-99)

Laser Radial Rig Male: Overall, Boys Under 19 (born 1996-97), Boys Under 17 (born 1998-99), Laser 4.7 Rig Male: Boys Under 18 (born 1997-98), Boys Under 16, (born 1999-2002)

Laser 4.7 Rig Female: Women (born before 1997), Girls Under 18 (born 1997-98), Girls Under 16 (born 1999 – 2002).

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.


