



2014 IFDS DISABLED SAILING PARALYMPIC CLASSES COMBINED WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Technical Delegate's Report By Costas Tsantilis

The 2014 IFDS Disabled Sailing Single-Person, Two-Person & Three-Person Keelboats World Championships were held at the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron in Halifax, Canada from 13 to 25 August 2014.

The organizing authority was the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron in conjunction with the International Association for Disabled Sailing (IFDS). This was the first qualifying event for the 2016 Paralympic Games Sailing Competition.

Organising Committee

The Organising Committee was led by the RNSYS previous Commodore Mrs. Heather Robertson The Technical Delegate Costas Tsantilis with the two Assistant TDs, Paul Tingley and Brian Todd, the Principal Race Officer (PRO) Robert Williams IRO/CAN, the International Jury Pat Healy J/USA and all the International Jury members and contributed to the development of the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

Communication between the key parties throughout the event was very effective.

Event Management

The Organising Committee appointed a number of key volunteers to manage the various aspects of the event onshore and afloat. Other roles during the event were delegated to a variety of individuals with appropriate skills.

Participation

Entries were received by the following 25 Nations: ARG, AUS, AUT, BRA, CAN, CZE, ESP, FIN, FRA, GBR, GER, GRE, JPN, IRL, ISR, ISV, ITA, KOR, NED, NOR NZL, POL, PUR, RUS, and USA. A total of 81 boats athletes: 49 at 2.4mR, 14 at Skud18 and 18 at Sonar with 131 competitors.

Race Management

Three course areas were used.

On course area A, the 2.4mR sailed a windward – leeward course finishing upwind. Course Race Officer was Robert Williams IRO/CAN

On course area B, the Sonar sailed a windward – leeward course, finishing downwind. Course Race Officer was Peter van Muyden IRO/CAN

On course area C the Skud 18 sailed a trapezoid course. Course Race Officer was David Le Roy IRO/AUS

They were assisted by three teams of local race management volunteers who had developed a strong team during other events.

Race Officials, accommodation and meals.

Accommodation, for all Race Officials was very well organized at the hotel Atlantica. Breakfast was offered at the Club house, Lunch boxes for Race officials were provided at the venue and a per diem was given to each one for daily dinners.

Three vans was provided for their transportation needs

Classification

Classification was governed by the IFDS Classification System and Procedures 2013 - 2016


