TUESDAY TALKS

The Talk on Tuesday, the 1st of March, is being presented by the Chairman of the Solent Protection Society, Mr Bill Pimlott, who has lived in Cowes since 1978. He is a retired Solicitor having been in private practice for 40 years and was President of the Isle of Wight Law Society in 1990. A keen sailor and a member of the Island Sailing Club for many years (Commodore 2007 - 2010), he was elected to the Solent Protection Council in 2011 and elected to Council Chairman 2013.

The Solent Protection Society, a registered charity, was founded in the 1950s by, amongst others, Sir Hugh Casson, the renowned architect, to fight against what the founder members saw as undesirable building construction around the Solent. Since then, the Society has expanded its remit to become both a guardian and an advisor regarding activity in and about the Solent which might be regarded as detrimental to its ecology and amenities. This might involve commenting on planning applications commenting on MCZs or funding research. The SPS is an independent body, funded entirely by voluntary donation, whose role is to preserve the Solent for all its users now and in the future. It is governed by its Council, which can call upon wide expertise to carry out its various activities.

I am sure this will be a most interesting Talk.

As usual the start time is 8pm, the Bar will be open from 6pm and Supper will be served between 6.30pm and 6.45pm to ensure supper is over in good time to allow the talk to start on schedule. Pre-booking for Supper is required either by putting your name on the list on the Club notice board or by ringing the Club on 872289.
