## DSBR and SBR Expressions of Interest Invitation

During 2013, National Grid developed and consulted on the design of 2 new Balancing Services, Demand Side Balancing Reserve (DSBR) and Supplemental Balancing Reserve (SBR). On 19<sup>th</sup> December 2013, Ofgem announced their decision to approve both services in an open letter to the industry (<a href="https://www.ofgem.gov.uk/publications-and-updates/national-grid%E2%80%99s-proposed-new-balancing-services-decision-letter">https://www.ofgem.gov.uk/publications-and-updates/national-grid%E2%80%99s-proposed-new-balancing-services-decision-letter</a>).

National Grid is currently further refining these products as well as developing methodology statements associated with determining the volume requirement, procurement / assessment of tenders and dispatch of the services in real time. A project team has also been appointed to prepare for the delivery of these products through competitive tender should they be required.

In advance of any competitive tender, National Grid has launched the following "Expressions of Interest" surveys to facilitate greater understanding of potential participant's service offerings and the volumes that may be available.
