APPENDIX 1.A – JOB DESCRIPTION FOR NATIONAL TRAINING MANAGER

Profile:

Broad based knowledge of sailing and related equipment in all forms

- Direct experience of training and educational techniques and concepts
- Extensive sailing experience as well as coaching competence
- Presentation skills
- Ability to communicate well through written and spoken word
- Sound judgement and common sense
- Leadership
- Negotiation at a national level
- Coaching and training qualifications and experience must be able to 'train' the Coaches
- Managerial experience
- Organizing, budget management

APPENDIX 1.B - THE ROLE OF THE VENUE MANAGER

The Venue Manager should be a qualified and experienced Coach, ideally a Senior Coach or have equivalent experience and skills..

The Venue Manager will be responsible for:

- Ensuring that all the *Training Venue* Accreditation requirements are met on a rolling daily basis;
- The Safety and Quality of all tuition at the *Training Venue*;
- The safety of *Participants* involved in training activity;
- Ensuring that all established safety requirements are monitored on a day to day basis;
- The *Venue Operating Procedure Manual* and ensuring that all training activities comply with this;
- All aspects of training and management of the *Training* Venue Coaches and volunteers;
- All training activities at the *Training Venue* are supervised by a person holding an appropriate and minimum valid qualification / certification;
- Ensuring that student / Coach ratios are observed;
- All training equipment is properly maintained and fit for purpose;
- Ensuring that powered Coach Boats are only used by suitably qualified and experienced people.
