1. Assumptions:

Please note that assumptions around costing government and partner contributions have changed compared to previous rounds. After internal discussion and guidance from J-PAL, the assumptions were updated as follows:

Only incremental marginal costs of the deworming program were considered in calculating government and partner costs. This means that teachers' and officials' time spent on deworming-related activities was not considered as part of the cost, unless they were specifically paid for that time in the form of an allowance. For example, if teachers received an allowance to attend training (in the form of travel or daily allowance) the payments were included in government costs. However, their time spent on actually carrying out deworming was not. Similarly, costs of venues were not considered, unless a particular venue was specifically hired for the purpose of deworming-related activities.
