




Lawyers who provide free secondary legal aid on permanent and temporary basis

Aid recipients




- Low-income persons
 - Disabled persons
- Orphan children

- If the person is under administrative detention / arrest
 - Suspected persons detained by inquiry and investigation bodies
 - If participation of defender is obligatory
